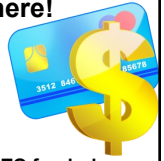
SCRIP ORDER INFORMATION: The next order will be due Feb. 18th.

H1N1 BOOSTER CLINIC

NEXT THURSDAY, FEB. 11TH, 1:30 P.M.

In order for children under the age of 10 to be fully protected against H1N1 influenza, they must receive two doses of the vaccine spaced at least four weeks apart.

Central District Health Department is coming to Falcon Ridge to hold a second dose clinic on Thursday, Feb. 11th at 1:30 p.m. for children under the age of 10 who need this booster.

Teachers, up through 5th grade, passed out consent forms this week to children who are 10 or younger and have had the first dose of the vaccine.

Additional forms for younger children may be picked up in the office any time before you visit the clinic. The vaccine is free and optional.
