Falcon Ridge Skate Night at Roller Drome in Nampa

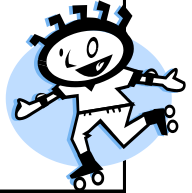
Who: Falcon Ridge students, family, and friends

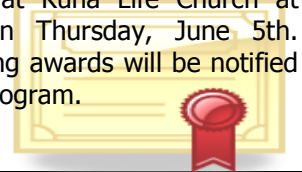
