Kindergarteners & 8th graders will not attend school Friday, as they graduate Thursday night.

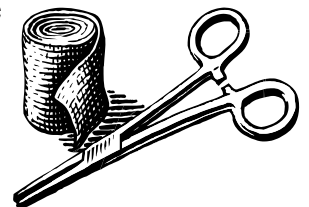
Students can take all of their things home on Thursday and do not need to bring anything Friday—we will spend our time cleaning and signing yearbooks.

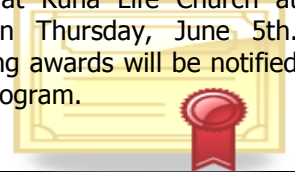
